ORDINANCE NO. 36-2014
(31st Regular Session)

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-09(N) ESTABLISHING THE MATERNAL CARE AND PUERICULTURE CENTER FOR THE CITY OF VALENCIA AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION THEREOF.

Prefatory Statement

The Maternal Care and Puericulture Center (MCPC) of the City of Valencia was established since year 2007, serving its constituencies for a period of time. It is noted that some of the provisions therein are no longer applicable and relevant in the current time. In this premise, there is a need to amend the funding utilization to establish a fair and equitable allocation to both professional services and staff, benefits and services to all its clients.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod in the City of Valencia, Bukidnon, in a regular session assembled, that;

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "An ordinance further amending Ordinance No. 2007-09(N) establishing the Maternal Care and Puericulture Center for the City of Valencia and appropriating funds for the operation thereof."

SECTION 2. AMENDMENTS. The following provisions of Ordinance No. 2007-09(N) are hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

Section 6. Philhealth Maternal Care Package. The Maternal Care and Puericulture Center (MCPC) shall be Php 8,000.00 per admission to cover room, medicine, professional fees of physician and laboratory fees but shall cover only 2nd, 3rd, and 4th child delivery. All primagravida (a woman who is pregnant for the first time), gravida Five (5) (a woman who is pregnant for the fifth time), and above are not allowed to be delivered in the MCPC or any birthing home unless the case is handled by an obstetrician.

Section 7. Non-Philhealth Member Package. The Maternal Care and Puericulture Center (MCPC) shall be entitled to collect fees for Non-Philhealth members. The maternal care and neonatal care package for non-Philhealth members shall be Php3,500.00 per admission.

The fee of Php 3,500.00 shall cover only the following services: pre-natal care, intrapartum care, newborn care and post natal services. Professional fees for Obstetrician shall be billed separately. Obstetrician of clients with PHIC coverage shall be paid in a manner provided in Section 11 herein, while clients not covered with PHIC shall be required to pay Php 3,500.00 for professional fee on top of the Php 3,500.00.

Section 8. Philhealth Newborn Care Package (NCP). The National Health Insurance Program aims to continuously provide its members and dependents with responsive benefits. The Philhealth Board has approved Resolution No. 925 series of 2006 providing for the Newborn Care Benefit Package.

The package shall be applicable to newborns of mothers who are qualified and have complied with PHIC requirements before availing of the pregnancy-related benefits.

Accredited health care providers should provide all necessary services within this package which consists of the following:

- a. Umbilical cord care
- b. Eye prophylaxis or Crede's Prophylaxis
- c. Vitamin K Intramuscular Injection
- d. Thermal Care
- e. First Dose of Hepatitis B immunization
- f. Newborn Screening Test as recommended by DOH
- g. BCG immunization

All newborns delivered in MCPC shall be evaluated by affiliated Pediatrician with professional fee of Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00) per patient which shall be charged to the neonatal care package of PHIC.

Section 10. Funding. The adjustment in their budget from Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php400,000.00) to Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php500,000.00) shall be effective 2011 Annual Budget or in the Supplemental Budget with an incremental increase of Five Percent (5%) per annum.

The above appropriation shall be allocated and expended as follows:

- 50% for medicines and supplies
- 10% for office supplies and forms
- 10% Secretariat Support and Trainings
- 10% Family Planning Advocacy program activities
- 10% delivery complications
- 10% laboratory reagents

Section 11. Resource Utilization. Collections from clients serviced by the MCPC including the Philhealth claims shall be utilized as follows:

A. 40% of the total resources shall be the share of the Local Government Unit and shall be appropriated for the following purposes:

- 50% for medicines and supplies
- 10% for office supplies and forms
- 10% Secretariat Support and Trainings
- 10% Family Planning Advocacy program activities
- 10% delivery complications
- 10% laboratory reagents

B. 60% of the total resources shall be utilized as follows: (Philhealth Circular No. 25,s. 2003 for Non-Hospital Health facility)

35.5% of 60% - for midwife services to less 30% for Hilot
64.5% of 60% - shall be divided into:

40% - Regular City Health physician
60% - shall be further divided into:


80% - MCPC Staff
20% - Barangay Health Worker

C. Professional fee for OB/Gyne in the amount of Php 2,500.00 per client served shall be taken from the pooled share of the regular City Health physicians.


SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect Fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
