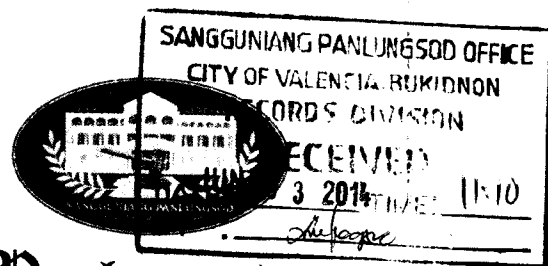

ORDINANCE NO. 38-2014 (37th Regular Session)

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE STALLHOLDERS IN THE FISH, MEAT AND VEGETABLE SECTIONS AT VALENCIA CENTRAL PUBLIC MARKET TO USE COOL DAYLIGHT BULB IN THEIR RESPECTIVE STALLS.

Explanatory Note

Valencia City is the food basket in the Province of Bukidnon. It has become a fast growing commercial trade centre upon the coming of investors and the rise of businesses in the City which resulted to the employment of many Valencianos.

It shall be the responsibility of the vendors to provide the best quality of products and goods to the consumers. To ensure the truthfulness of this objective, it is proper to use cool daylight bulb in their stalls for the consumers to clearly see and examine the goods they are about to purchase.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in the City of Valencia, Bukidnon, in a regular session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "An ordinance mandating the stallholders in the fish, meat and vegetable sections at Valencia Central Public Market to use cool daylight bulb in their respective stalls.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. In order to avoid/prevent the display and selling of contaminated and/or adulterated products in the market, stallholders in the

fish, meat and vegetable sections are mandated to use cool daylight bulb in their stalls. The use of colored/yellow/orange light bulb is strictly prohibited.

SECTION 3. IMPLEMENTING OFFICE. The City Economic Enterprise Office will be responsible for the implementation of this ordinance. Stallholders found violating this ordinance shall be penalized with the following:

- For the 1st offense - One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00);
- For the 2nd offense - Three Thousand Pesos (Php3,000.00); and
- For the 3rd offense - Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) and cancellation of business permit for one (1) year.

SECTION 4. PUBLIC INFORMATION CAMPAIGN. The City Economic Enterprise, in coordination with the City Licensing Office of the City of Valencia, private institutions and organizations, with the local media, shall undertake an information campaign for a period of two (2) months for the attainment of the objectives of this ordinance.


SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining part of this Ordinance not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or part thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation and posting of the same at least in three (3) public conspicuous places.
