**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 24-2014 APPROVING THE FIVE PERCENT (5%) GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) OF CITY ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2014 IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY SIX MILLION THREE HUNDRED THIRTY TWO THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FOUR PESOS (PHP36,332,804.00).**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in the City of Valencia, Bukidnon in a regular session assembled, that:

**SECTION I.** The amount Thirty Six Million Three Hundred Thirty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Four Pesos (Php36,332,804.00) is hereby appropriated in the City treasury to provide for the Executive Budget, 5% Gender and Development (GAD) of this city for Calendar Year 2014.

**SECTION IV. RESPONSIBILITY.**



**SECTION V. EFFECTIVITY.**


This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
